CRUISING CHECKLIST (Take this sheet with you on the day)

BRIEFING Hold a briefing with the other groups using the water that day and with your duty team

OPEN the clubhouse and **GOOSE GATES**

FLAGS hoist appropriate flags on flagstaff and return to race office afterwards

RADIOS ensure you can communicate with the clubhouse in an emergency. Most ribs have fixed radios.
There are hand held radios in the boat house cupboard.

KILL CORDS: safety team please check they work every time you go afloat

Ideally take your **MOBILE PHONE** on the water in a dry bag for emergencies

FUEL TANKS all tanks returned to store

ISOLATOR to be returned to the cupboard at end of the day

GATES LOCKED & GOOSE GATES CLOSED at end of day

HEATERS & LIGHTS OFF at end of day

CLUBHOUSE and BOATHOUSE locked
